

Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium Planned Expenditure 2018-19

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2). In the academic year 2016/17 the Academy will receive £23,500 for eligible students. This is the same amount as we received last year.

Please find below the details of the planned support to be put in place for students and the intended outcomes of that support. Please note that support will be allocated according to need and so not all eligible students will received every action included. Students may also be eligible for additional support through our Pupil Premium interventions. For more information please refer to our Pupil Premium Statement which is available on our website.

Maths Mastery	£1152	All year 7 students	The Mathematics Mastery program is a whole-school approach to teaching mathematics that aims to raise attainment for all pupils and close the attainment gap between pupils from low income families and their peers. Maths Specialist	£3910	Targeted students	Maths TA working solely in Maths focusing on small group work in KS3.	
Hegarty Maths	£383.36	All year 7 students	Hegarty Maths is a specialized program which gives bespoke feedback and exercises based on teachers marking and performance in exercises. This program allows the classroom teacher to know in detail the areas for improvement of our targeted Catch-up Premium students.	
Accelerated reader	£4200	All Y7 students	All year 7 students are monitored and assessed on AR. This allows the librarian and class teachers to monitor reading, comprehension and literacy progress of our targeted Catch-up Premium students.	
Librarian	£8451	All Y7 students	Our librarian works closely with our Catch-up premium students, monitoring and working with them during tutor time, supporting our Aspire group and the peer reading. Our Librarian also monitors and maintains AR and Literacy Assessment tool and educates students on how to use the programs.	
Literacy Assessment tool	£1638	All Y7 students	This program measures literacy and reading comprehension levels of all our students in Y7.	
Peer reading	£100	Targeted Catch-up premium students/ Aspire students	Older competent readers in Y10 work with building reading confidence and fluency during registration with our targeted Y7 students. This work takes place in the library.	

RWCM Intervention Wave 1 Teaching Baseline assessments	£2765.6 £400 £500	All Catch-up premium students	Bespoke individual and very small group support for catch-up premium students in Reading Writing Communication and Maths lead by specialist TAs. These sessions focused on spelling strategies, reading comprehensions, understanding maths terminology and number skills.	
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
